Providence Baptist Church Mother's Day Out Policy Statement 2021

Children, 6 weeks to school aged are welcomed to attend our year-round program at Providence Baptist Church. Mother's Day Out meets Mon/Wed or Tue/Thurs each week from 9:30 am until 2:00 pm. During June and July, our Summer Safari welcomes children up to 12 years of age. We ask that parents be prompt for drop off and pick up. Please notify us if your child is going to be absent. Parents need to sign their child/children in at their appropriate rooms and bring the following items for each child labeled with their name:

- 1. Lunch and drink bottle
- 2. Change of cloths
- 3. Diapers or Pull ups and Wet Wipes
- 4. Play pen sheet and blanket if needing to nap.

In the event of inclement weather, we follow the Hamilton County School system for closures. We will post on our private Facebook page "Mother's Day Out Ooltewah" by 7am.

Fees: Registration Fee: \$20 (1 child); \$10 for each additional child.

Activity Fee: \$30 per term, starting August, January, and June.

Monthly Fee: Due the first of the month. 1 child \$20 per day, 2nd child \$18.75 per day, 3rd child \$17.50

For 1 day a week: \$80 (1 child); \$155 (2 children); \$225 (3 children) For 2 days a week: \$160 (1 child); \$310 (2 children); \$450 (3 children)

Extended Time Fee: For late pick-ups, the fee is \$5 per day.

Early Drop Off Fee: \$5 per day. Early drop off time is no earlier than 8:45. 2

Drop-in Rate: \$25 per day per child.

In order to enroll your child in the sessions, fees must be paid in full. All payments are due the first day of the month that your child attends. There will be no credit given for personal days missed, only for inclement weather closures will a credit be issued. No refund will be issued for the month paid in advance if the guardians should decide to no longer participate in MDO.

Illness Policy:

A child must be <u>free of the following symptoms for at least 24 hours without medicine</u> before he or she can return to class:

Fever Diarrhea Vomiting Lice Cold or Flu

(This includes: Unexplained rashes, blisters, bumps, or swelling and Any other symptoms that would qualify as illness.) In order to keep the spread of infections down, as well as for your own child's best interest, if your child begins to exhibit any of the above symptoms while under the care of our program, you will be expected to return and pick him or her up as quickly as possible. We regularly check temperatures and keep an eye on the wellbeing of your child. We will welcome them back when they have been symptom free for 24 hours.

If your family has been exposed to COVID-19 we ask that your child wait 14 days before returning to MDO.

We will always redirect and ancourage your shild to participate listen stay on tack, and do their heat. Three warning
